



Why is it uniquely difficult to serve children outside of family care?



- Thought to be the most vulnerable
- Lacking critical information about them
- Delivering interventions for them is harder
- We lack research to validate the common understanding of the impact a parent has on a child

A New Approach to Serving Children without Families



- Antibiotic: A drug used to treat an infection caused by a bacteria or related microorganism.
- 1926 - Alexander Fleming discovered Penicillin.
- Today, over 100 kinds of antibiotics are commonly available.
- Assess the infection and prescribe the most appropriate prescription.
